

Dublin 8 Sales Market Review 2020



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The Dublin 8 property market was very resilient despite COVID-19. We saw strong demand for all property types but especially for houses in turn-key condition. Our average selling price was €392,367 or €468 per sq. ft., 1.7% above asking prices and 1.8% higher year on year. The most motivated buyers we dealt with were first-time buyers who accounted for 73% of all buyers.

Our average selling time was 11.3 weeks, compared to 10 weeks in 2019. Dublin 8 is a very cosmopolitan quarter with 40% of our buyers coming from Europe, Asia and South America. There was a drop in transactions compared to 2019 which is not surprising given lockdown measures. Looking forward for 2021, we expect an increase in transactions and values to increase but not markedly.






